

RULE 30- DETAILED DRAWING OF WATER PIPING TO BE FURNISHED IN CERTAIN CASES

Section 1. Upon request by the County, the owner of the premises engaged in commercial, industrial or institutional activity shall furnish the County with a suitable detailed drawing illustrating the water piping serving such premises. No changes in any such water piping system shall be made until the same shall have been approved by the County.

Section 2. If any water consumer required by this Rule to furnish a water piping diagram shall fail to furnish such detailed drawing within ten (10) days after being notified by the Sanitary Engineer to do so, then such failure shall constitute sufficient cause for the County to discontinue water service to the premises of such consumer until such detailed drawing has been furnished.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation who makes application for a new water service connection to serve commercial, industrial or institutional premises shall submit a water piping detailed drawing to the Sanitary Engineer for review and approval. No permit for connection to the Water Distribution System shall be issued until such approval has been granted.

Section 4. Residential premises are exempt from the provisions of this Rule, however, the County reserves the right to inspect the water piping of residential premises if there is reasonable cause to believe that a potential or actual cross connection exists.
