

**ADDITIONAL LIMITATIONS/PROVISIONS REGARDING ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT &
THE TRANSPORTATION/MOVEMENT OF OVERSIZE LOADS**

1. Issuance of this permit only authorizes movement on highways under control of the Erie County Engineer (Highway Department) or the political subdivisions (Township(s)) of Erie County specified on this permit. Permission to travel on State Routes, The Ohio Turnpike, City Streets or any other roadway not covered by this permit, must be obtained from the proper authorities.
2. Hauler is responsible for checking all routes prior to movement of permitted load to ensure that the movement of the vehicle/load can be completed safely.
3. No vehicle(s) or load being moved under this permit shall be left parked on the roadway either day or night except in the case of an emergency, in which case adequate protection shall be provided for the traveling public. The vehicle(s) shall not be loaded or unloaded within the limits of the highway.
4. The operator of the vehicle must comply with all laws, rules, or regulations covering the movement of traffic over highways and streets.
5. Permits will not generally be issued for built-up loads that are divisible into legal loads or loads that have not been loaded to the least over dimension.

WARNING FLAGS AND SIGNS

1. Warning flags shall be 18 inches square, red or orange in color, in good repair and free of printing or other markings. Flags shall be securely fastened by at least one corner or securely mounted on a staff.
2. Warning flags shall be displayed on all over dimensioned vehicles and loads.
3. Over width vehicles and loads shall bear two flags at the widest extremities of the load as well as one flag at each corner of the vehicle or load. Warning flags are not required to be displayed on the tractor (power unit).
4. Over length vehicles and loads or vehicles and loads with a rear overhang of 4 feet or greater shall display a single flag at the extreme rear if the over length or projecting part is two feet wide or less. Two flags shall be displayed if the over length or projecting portion is wider than two feet and the flags should be located to indicate maximum width.
5. Warning signs, when required, shall read "OVERSIZE LOAD" and shall be at least 7 feet long and 18 inches high. The signs background shall be yellow. The letters (OVERSIZE LOAD) shall be black and at least 10 inches high with a minimum 1.41 inch brush stroke.
6. OVERSIZE LOAD signs shall be displayed on any vehicle or vehicle/load exceeding the maximum legal length limit as set in the Ohio Revised Code, Section 5577.05
7. OVERSIZE LOAD signs shall be displayed on any vehicle or vehicle/load with an overall width of 10 feet or greater.
8. OVERSIZE LOAD signs shall be displayed on any vehicle or vehicle/load with an overall height in excess of 14 feet 6 inches.
9. OVERSIZE LOAD signs, when required, shall be displayed on the front and rear of the over dimensioned vehicle or vehicle/load.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR VEHICLES OR VEHICLE/LOAD COMBINATIONS THAT EXCEED STATE MAXIMUM WEIGHT LIMITS

1. If a permit is issued for a specific vehicle or vehicle/load combination that exceeds State maximum weight limits, the permit will be issued for a specific time period. Although a fee will not be assessed again for moving the same vehicle or vehicle/load combination during the permitted time, the Erie County Engineer's Office (419-627-7710) **must** be contacted before the vehicle or vehicle/load combination is moved (on any roadway covered by this permit) so that a particular route can be specified as well as any other special provisions that the move may necessitate. No weights may exceed any weight parameters specified for the same vehicle/load on a permit granted for said vehicle/load by the Ohio Department Of Transportation. Failure to contact the Erie County Engineer's Office prior to the below listed vehicle/load being moved shall render this permit null and void.

2. The following information must be provided before authorization will be granted to move any vehicle or vehicle/load combination that exceeds State Maximum Weight Limits: Description of Load (specify any dimension that exceeds State legal limits) _____

**** Any movement of a vehicle/load that is 10 (ten) feet or more wide is prohibited on any roadway covered by this permit from sunset to sunrise.**

***** Any load with an overall height in excess of 14 feet 10 inches shall be required to coordinate the move with the owners of all overhead signs, signals, utilities, etc., which may obstruct safe, clear movement.**

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH ANY PROVISION OF THIS PERMIT, EXCEEDING THE GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHTS OR DIMENSIONS GRANTED OR THE COMMISSION OF ANY VIOLATION FOR OFFENSES THAT ARE RELEVANT TO THE SAFE MOVEMENT OF A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE (for example (but not limited to), Speed, Reckless Operation, OVI, Improper Lane Change, etc.) SHALL RENDER THE PERMIT NULL AND VOID, AND THE VEHICLE OPERATOR SUBJECT TO ADDITIONAL ENFORCEMENT ACTION.
